This program will allow skilled, motivated, and driven Ohio Opportunity Youth (OOY) who are interested in pursuing education and training to launch their career. With additional support from the Industry Sector Partnership Grant, Columbus State Community College, and The Buckeye Ranch we are committed to designing a new career pathway to empower OOY to overcome adversity, achieve goals, and become productive members of our community.

The next Fostering Futures cohort is scheduled to begin in Summer 2025 in Central Ohio, with applications opening in Spring 2025.



Culinary Skills Training

Youth will participate in tailored coursework provided by Columbus State Community College, with the opportunity to complete an optional credit assessment at the end.

Success Coaching



Contracted through the Buckeye Ranch, the Success Coach will provide participating OOY with career assistance and resource connections beginning with orientation, through post-placement job mentoring.

The Success Coach will distribute Emergency and Normalcy Funds as needed to reduce barriers to success.



Employer Engagement

Hospitality and Food Service Employers will collaborate with the Ohio Children's Alliance to provide paid internships.
